

The Challenge:

- ▶ Design, construct and exhibit a toy made from 2x6(nominal size) pine lumber of no more than 18 inches in length
- ▶ Toys to be exhibited and judged at Summer Seminar

Purpose:

- ▶ To promote WWCH's toy-maker mission
 - ▶ Within the Club
 - ▶ To the public
- ▶ To provide new toy designs for WWCH members to:
 - ▶ Make for distribution to WWCH-supported charities
 - ▶ Make for themselves
 - ▶ Include in future editions of WWCH book of wood toy patterns

Material:

- ▶ Up to 18-inches of 2"x 6" (nominal size) **pine** lumber, or equivalent
- ▶ Actual dimensions: 1-½"x 5-½"x 18"
 - ▶ Any number of pieces
 - ▶ Two pieces ¾" thick
 - ▶ Three pieces ½" thick
 - ▶ Four pieces, 2 @ ¼" thick + 2 @ ½" thick
- ▶ Does not require "construction" lumber
 - ▶ Dimensioned lumber is acceptable

Entry:

- ▶ Two copies of each toy
 - ▶ #1: Undecorated **pine**(with transparent finish, if desired)
 - ▶ #2: Same design as #1, in any species, as many species as desired, transformed and decorated as desired
 - ▶ Laminations, inlay, veneer – all allowed
 - ▶ Transform the entry, but **NO** added components
 - ▶ Show off your woodworking skill and artistry

Design:

- ▶ Unique all-wood design
- ▶ No additional material other than . . .
 - ▶ Glue
 - ▶ Wheels and axles
 - ▶ String and grip for pull toy
- ▶ Wheels sets may be obtained from WWCH, other sources, or shop made
 - ▶ No penalty in wood allowance for wheel sets

Other:

- ▶ Maker agrees to relinquish exclusive rights to the toy design
- ▶ Maker agrees WWCH may make and use images of toy, with acknowledgement to maker
- ▶ Pine entries will be retained by WWCH; decorated entries will be returned to maker
